 - C) Obtained minimum of 60% marks in principle in all subjects in the latest examination

at school and overall minimum average of 60% marks in all subjects for the past two years;

- D) Learners of Japanese. Participants for the Japanese speech contests are encouraged to apply and have priority for the selection,
- E) Demonstrate strong potential of leadership to act as a bridge between the home country and Japan during and after the program; and
- F) Not have participated in the ASIA KAKEHASHI program before.
